Great Horkesley Parish Council Meeting 25 February 2020

1. Reported to Essex County Council the following issues:
 - Flooding
 - Faulty street lights
 - Lit Bollards on the A134 Nayland Road one missing and one not working.
 - Pot Holes
 - Received an update that the damaged 30mph sign on the A134 near to Terrace Hall Chase is due to be replaced.

2. I previously contacted the Colchester Borough Council manager of Neighbourhood Services for replacement road name plates for Holly Lane I have also requested an update on the replacement road signs for Old House Road at the junction with Coach Road. and Coach Road at the junction with London Road which I requested previously.

3. Ordered and replaced two defibrillator pads, the battery has also been checked all working and has an expiry date up to 5 years 2021-22.

4. Increase in price from Panther Security CCTV in April 2020 of 1.4% cost is now £91.26.

5. I contacted Essex Police to organise a PCSO to attend the monthly tea afternoon in the hall, two PCSO 's came out to speak to residents.

6. PRS/PPL Licensing have charged us PPL for the previous year as this was not correctly invoiced for the year 2019-2020, I challenged their decision as this was an administration error on their part as all information was supplied as requested, they were going to go back further years to charge the parish council, therefore the price has increased significantly, which were not aware of at budget time.
