Parish Council meetings are held on the 3rd Wednesday of each month. Meetings are held in the new village hall and start at 7:30 pm. All meetings are open to the public. There is usually a 15 minute Public Open Forum, item is near to the start of the meeting at which members of the public may speak, usually for no more than 3 minutes though this may be extended at the Chairman's absolute discretion.

The Village Hall Committee usually meets quarterly on a Wednesday morning. Members of the public may attend but not speak except by prior arrangement with the Clerk.

Notice of meetings and agendas are posted on the notice boards at the Half Butt Inn, and near the Village Hall, they are also put onto the web site three clear days before the meeting (see dates below).
